WHAT IS A LLEN?

Local Learning and Employment Networks (LLENs) are a grouping or network of organisations and individuals interested and involved in education, training and employment, in particular how these relate to young people aged 10-19 years. There are 31 LLENs across Victoria. Established in 2001, LLEN's are incorporated associations and are legal entities in their own right.

WynBay LLEN is contracted to broker strategic, sustainable partnerships that support improved education and transition outcomes for young people. This includes increasing Year 12 or equivalent attainment rates. A LLENs core objective is to improve participation, engagement, attainment and transition outcomes for young people 10-19 years old within its geographic boundaries. LLENs also have a particular focus on those young people who are at risk of disengaging or who have already disengaged from education and training, and who are not in meaningful employment.
