- improving education and transition outcomes for all young people.

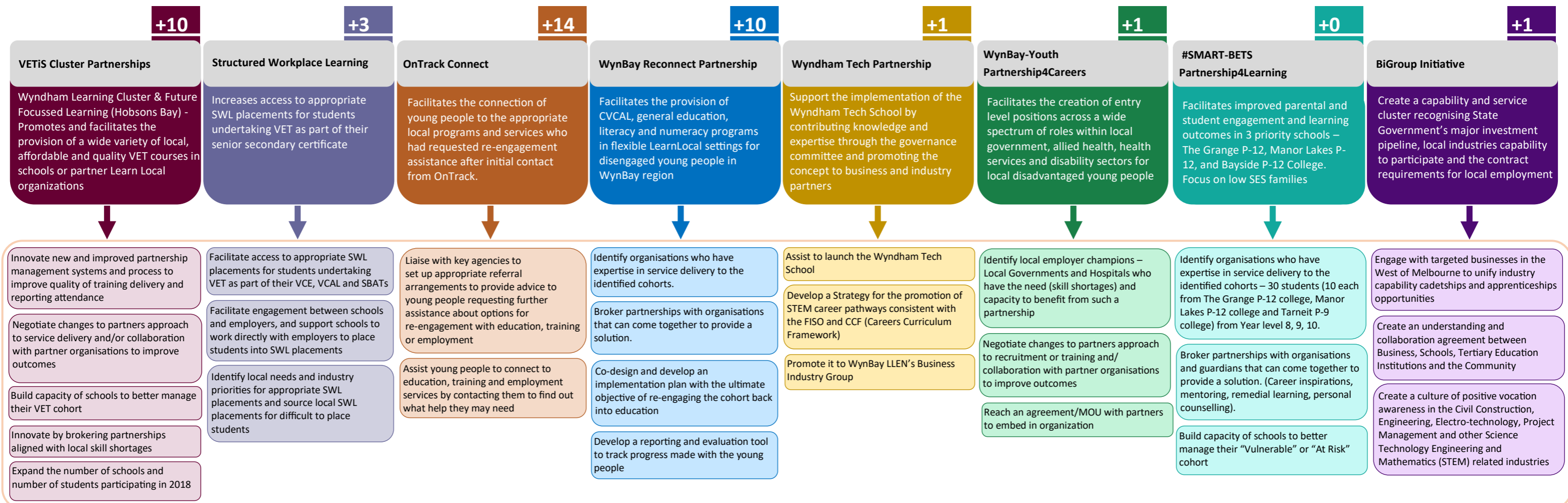
ROLE: Relationships/Partnerships Broker
